Key Vocabulary:

Print - The transfer of text or designs to paper.



Rubbings - To take a rubbing of a pattern by rubbing on paper laid over it with coloured wax or pencil



Key Facts:

Printing in art is the process of transferring ink or paint from a design onto a surface.

Printmaking is a technique that allows a design to be repeated multiple times.

We can use charcoal to draw lines that are very light or very dark.
