Network - connects two or more computers and communication devices

Router - a device that communicates between the internet and the devices in your home that connect to the internet.

Server - a computer that manages and stores files, or one that provides services to other computers on the network

wireless access point (WAP) - a device that allows people to connect Wi-Fi devices
