Key Facts


Gandhi was born on October 2, 1869 in Porbandar, Gujarat, India.

On the anniversary of Gandhi's birth, **Gandhi Jayanti** is celebrated.

People followed Gandhi 240 miles across India in protest. This was called the Salt March.
