Literacy

- Understand the 5 key concepts about print
- To develop phonological awareness so that they can spot and suggest rhyme and count and clap syllables in a word
- Engage in conversations about stories learning new vocabulary

Understanding the world/ Expressive Art and Design

- Use senses to explore natural materials
- Explore collections of materials with similar and/or different properties
- Talk about what they see
- Take part in simple pretend play, using an object to represent something else
- Explore different materials freely
- Listen with increased attention to sounds
- Respond to what they have heard

Personal, Social and Emotional

- Values—Kindness/self-control
- Select, use activities /resources
- To develop their sense of responsibility and membership of a community
- To become more outgoing with unfamiliar people
- Increasingly follow rules understanding why they are important

Communication and Language

- Enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember much of what happens
- Use a wider range of vocabulary
- To understand a question or instruction that has two parts, such as "Get your coat and wait at the door."

Mathematics

- Recognise up to 3 objects (subitising)
- Recite numbers past 5
- Say one number for each item in order
- Talk about, explore 2D shapes using informal and mathematical language.
- Make comparisons between objects (size, weight, length and capacity)
- Begin to describe a sequence of events using words such as first...then...etc

Physical development

- To develop their movement, balancing, riding and ball skills
- To climb steps with alternate feet
- To use large scale movements to wave flags and streamers, paint and make marks
- Use one handed tools and equipment
- Be increasingly independent when meeting health care needs
