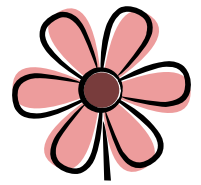

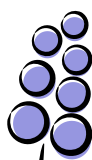
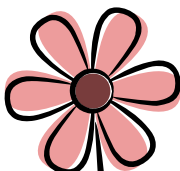
## Religious Education
