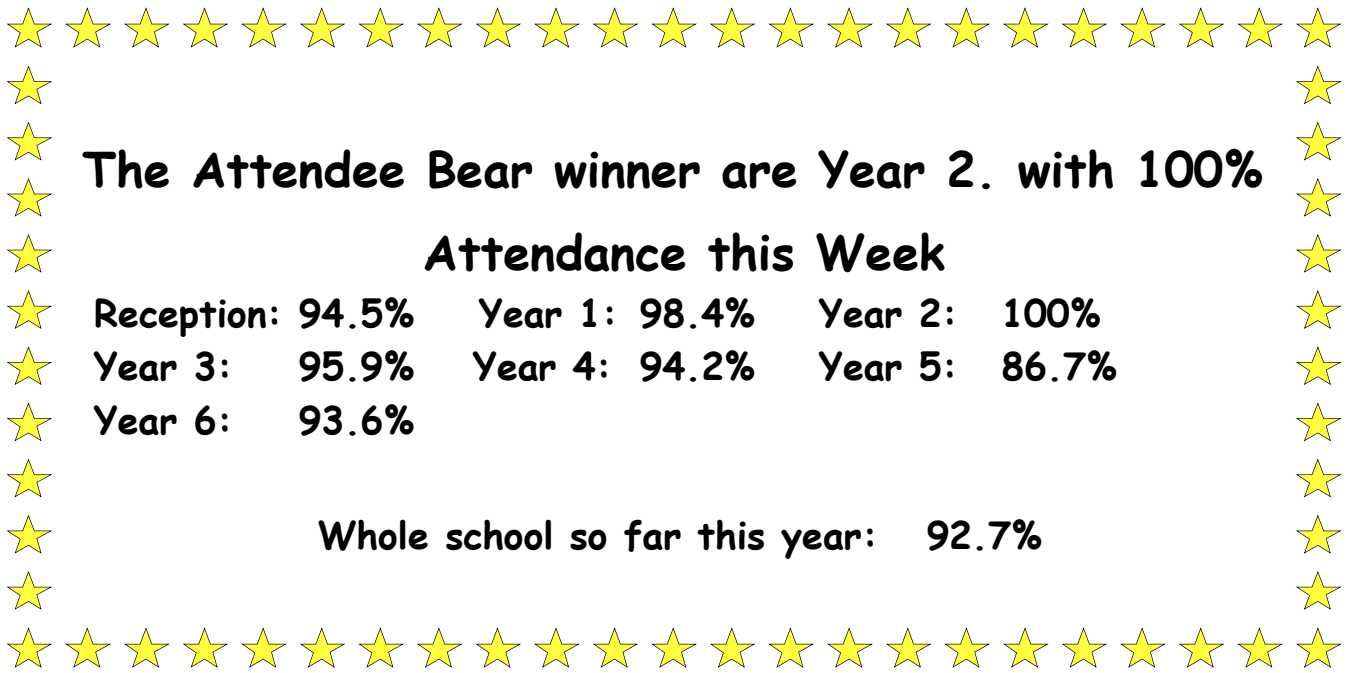
If your child is unable to have their face painted then please let their class teacher know before the end of year performance.

## Reminder of our Uniform Policy

- *Boys* - Navy blue trousers, **light blue** polo shirt or long/short sleeved light blue shirt, **claret** jumper or sweatshirt bearing the school logo. **Black** coloured footwear, suitable for school, must be worn.
  - *Girls* - Navy blue skirts or trousers, light blue polo shirt or long sleeved light blue blouse, **claret** jumper bearing the school logo. During summer months a **blue/white** checked dress or **red/white** checked dress may be worn. **Dark** plain coloured tights and **black** coloured footwear, suitable for school, must be worn.
