### Reports

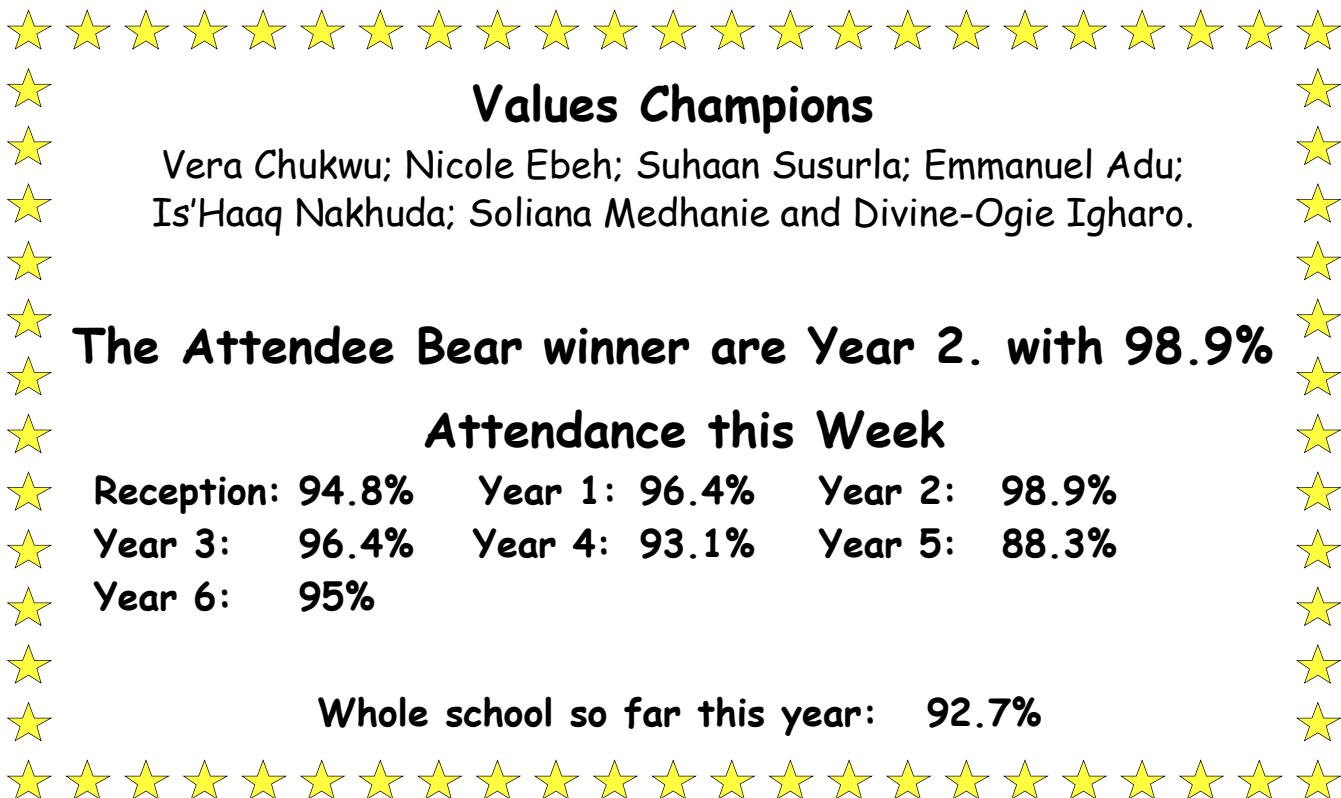
The End of Year Reports will be sent home early next week.
